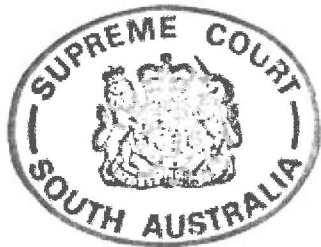

THE COURT ORDERS that:

1. The Court orders that Applicant's application to strike off the Respondent's name from the roll of practitioners be refused.
2. The Respondent, Nathan William Thompson, is reprimanded for the unprofessional conduct committed by him as a legal practitioner between October 2010 and March 2011, as found by the Legal Practitioners Disciplinary Tribunal on 12 October 2017 in LPDT 10 of 2015.
3. There is no order as to the costs of and incidental to the Applicant's within application.
4. The Respondent is to pay the Applicant's costs of and incidental to the proceedings against him in the Legal Practitioners Disciplinary Tribunal, LPDT 10 of 2015, to be taxed in default of agreement.
